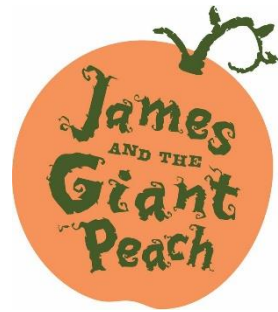

The 2017-2018 Acting Workshop Season!



Having taught children through seven successful past workshops, including the recent Winter 2017 production of *The Lion, the Witch, & The Wardrobe*; Yellow Fun Entertainment is pleased to announce its 2017-2018 Acting Workshop Season for children ages 7-14 called “A Year of Believing” in which students have the opportunity to participate in stretching their imagination beyond the realms of the possible! Students will also learn important life skills such as voice projection, articulation, teamwork and responsibility! Our “Year of Believing” will help students discover what it means to create good friendships, learn to do the right thing even in the toughest of situations, and nurture their talents/skills in two workshops.

The Fall of 2017 will kick off the year with the acting workshop of *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz* taught by Cindy Bell and Elizabeth Janssen will teach the Winter’s *James & The Giant Peach* workshop. Both will be produced by Josef Silvia, who has over 15 years’ experience in the field. Classes for *The Wonderful Wizard of Oz* will be held on Saturdays from 9:30AM-12:30 PM, September 16th thru November 12th. On November 12th, we will have our culminating acting workshop performance at 2 PM. *James & The Giant Peach* will meet for 10 Saturdays, beginning January 13th and lasting through March 24th. There will be no class on Saturday, February 24th due to the Dedham Winter School Vacation. Class will meet at 9:30 AM till 12:30 PM. Our performance of the workshop will be on Saturday, March 24th at 2 PM after the regular class time. Students should wear sneakers and bring a small snack to each class. All students should bring a lunch and at least two water bottles on our performance days.

Tuition for the school year is \$165 per student for each workshop, or \$310 for both. Classes and performances will be held at The Motherbrook Arts & Community Center, 123 High Street, Dedham, MA. Tuition is non-refundable after the first day of class. Students are responsible for their own costumes.
